PUTTING THE CHILDREN FIRST

Ben Affleck is using his struggles as a learning tool. The dad of Violet, 11, Seraphina, 8, and Samuel, 5 (with estranged wife **Jennifer Garner**), revealed in a March 14 Facebook statement that he recently completed treatment for alcohol addiction. "I want my kids to know there is no shame in getting help when you need it," wrote the 44-year-old Oscar winner, who also went to rehab in 2001. "I'm lucky to have the love of my family and friends, including my coparent, Jen."

The next day, he jumped back into his dad duties, dropping the children off at their L.A. school and taking them to church March 19. Says an Affleck pal, "The kids are happy to have him back and doing well."

MODERN FAMILY For the children's benefit, Affleck and Garner — who separated in June 2015 after 10 years of marriage — both live on the same 3-acre Pacific Palisades property. (Affleck resides in the guesthouse; Garner is in the main home.) "Jen wants them to have a healthy father,"


says a source close to the actress, 44. "She will do whatever it takes to provide the best arrangement." Though divorce is still on the table — neither has filed — the duo are maintaining their status quo. While Affleck works on his sobriety, "Jen continues to be there, and she always will be there for him," adds the Garner insider. "He is very appreciative of Jen being so supportive and for giving him a chance to get better. They are not a couple by any means, but they . . . will continue to be the best parents they can be."

Mischa Barton is getting unwanted exposure. The 31-year-old is “the victim of revenge pornography,” her lawyer Lisa Bloom said in a statement March 14. The next day, Barton explained at a press conference that an ex secretly filmed her having sex and is shopping the tape to porn sites for \$500,000. “She’s distraught,” says a Barton source. Now the actress is threatening the seller with legal action. “No woman should have to go through this,” she told reporters. “I am finally standing up for myself.”

On March 17, first lady Melania Trump, clad in a belted custom Alice Roi coatdress, Gianvito Rossi stilettos and Gucci sunglasses, strode across the White House lawn with her husband, Donald. With the press corps photographers snapping away, the 46-year-old Slovenia-born stunner smiled for the cameras as the billionaire awkwardly reached for her hand and clutched the tips of her fingers. Once the obligatory photo op was complete, she, Donald and their 11-year-old son, Barron, boarded Marine One, POTUS' helicopter, which whisked them away to their Palm Beach, Florida, estate, Mar-a-Lago. Aboard the chopper — and away from the public eye — Melania dropped the act. And Donald's hand. "Melania," alleges a family source, "does not keep hidden from everyone around her how miserable she is."

That includes the president himself. Multiple sources claim that the former fashion model — who's currently living 200 miles away from Washington, D.C., in NYC's Trump Tower while Barron finishes the school year — refuses to share a bed with Donald even on the rare occasions when they sleep in the same city. "They have separate bedrooms," says another Trump insider. "They never spend the night together — ever." (A third

source says the couple do sleep in the same room but keep separate beds: "It's very 'royal' of them!") Upset with the 70-year-old former reality star for trapping her in a life she despises, "Melania wants as little to do with Donald as possible," explains the family source. "She is not interested in Donald, the presidency or anything involving him."

WIFE STRIFE

She has made that abundantly clear. Since

"I'm strong, I'm confident, I'm living my life," Melania told Anderson Cooper in October, after her husband's "pussy" tape leaked.

assuming the role of first lady January 20, Melania has kept an extremely limited official schedule. After the inauguration, she mostly stayed in her gilded Fifth Avenue triplex penthouse and didn't set foot in the nation's capital again for 21 days. And the few official appearances she *has* made were done so begrudgingly. Melania escorted Akie Abe, the Japanese prime minister's wife, around Palm Beach in February, but "only because she was going to be at Mar-a-Lago already," according to the family source. "She refused to do it in Washington." Her March 2 trip to read Dr. Seuss' *Oh, the Places You'll Go!* to kids in the pediatrics ward of the New York-Presbyterian Hospital was also a chore. "The White House put a lot of pressure

on her to do that," continues the source, who claims Melania is self-conscious about her thick accent and public speaking since the Michelle Obama plagiarism debacle at the Republican National Convention July 18. "They have to talk her into doing everything."

Who could blame her? "This life wasn't her dream," a Trump family friend, stylist Phillip Bloch, recently told *Us*. "It was Donald's." Indeed, the deeply private 5-foot-11 beauty moved to the United States in 1996 to launch a fashion career — not to preside over the East Wing. Now she's a pop culture punch line. "[Donald has] her as, like, a hostage up in this Trump Tower. She's like Rapunzel!" cohost Joy Behar quipped as the ladies of *The View* debated the first couple's romantic chemistry March 14. "I don't believe these two. I don't buy it."

What's more, many of the perks of being Mrs. Trump have vanished. Designers including Phillip Lim and Marc Jacobs, turned off by Donald's populist policies, have refused to dress Melania. "It isn't about people dressing her," claims the family source. "She has enough money to dress herself. She is upset she has been shunned." She's also getting the cold shoulder from Hollywood. (Remember Meryl Streep's scathing speech at the Golden Globes?) Though she once rubbed elbows with A-listers at events such as the *Vanity Fair* Oscar party, "that entire world that she used to enjoy," asserts the family source, "is closed to her."

To cope, Melania — who wed Donald in 2005 in front of guests including Katie Couric, Kelly Ripa and

Tony Bennett — sticks to low-key time with family. Her dad, Viktor Knave, a former car salesman, and mom, Amalija, keep an apartment in Trump Tower, and her sister, artist Ines Knauss, lives just a few blocks away. "She spends most of her time with them," says the family source, who adds that Ines is Melania's BFF. "Melania confides everything to her."

Her only child also provides a distraction. "Barron is the priority for now," the stepmom of Donald Jr., 39, Ivanka, 35, Eric, 33, and Tiffany, 23, explained to *Us* last year. "He needs me at this age."

Nevertheless, duty calls — and Melania will continue going through the first-lady motions for the foreseeable future. Case

in point: She announced in March that she will host the annual Easter egg roll at the White House April 17. "The White House convinced her to do it," says the family source. "She agreed because she won't have to be alone with Donald or

spend the night. She only wants to do public things where she doesn't have to be alone with him."

WHAT'S NEXT?

With intense pressure from her husband's advisers to present a united front, Melania finally has begun to mull a move to the nation's capital. Though multiple sources have told *Us* she had hoped to remain in New York City with Barron throughout her husband's term, the White House continues to insist she will relocate to 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue this June. One well-connected insider reveals Melania has even toured schools in Washington, D.C., and in suburban Maryland to find a suitable place for Barron to study.

If she does indeed make the 20,000-square-foot White House living quarters her home base, Melania (who once joked that "the key" to her happy marriage with Donald is separate bathrooms) should be pleased to know that the executive residence has plenty of bedrooms too: five, to be exact. **US**

He raised the roof, bobbed from side to side and attempted the two-handed point. As Luniz's 1995 rap classic "I Got 5 on It" played in Farinet South — an underground club in Verbier, Switzerland — in the early hours of March 13, Prince William showed off his fiercest dance moves. Visiting the Swiss town for a ski trip with three pals, the royal "had been drinking since the afternoon," explains a friend. By 3 A.M., "he was more than tipsy." At one point, the father of Prince George, 3, and Princess Charlotte, 22 months, even placed his hand on the waist of a mystery woman, thought to be 24-year-old Australian model Sophie Taylor. "Things got a little messy," admits the friend, "but occasionally Dad has to let his hair down! It was all clean, harmless fun."

Within 24 hours, it was headline news. By March 14, TMZ had released video of William's dad dance moves and U.K. paper *The Sun* slammed the former air-ambulance pilot, 34, for snubbing the annual March 13 Commonwealth Day events to live it up with his buddies and Taylor. Two days later, *Vanity Fair* piled on, claiming Duchess Kate

wasn't pleased with her husband's antics. But a source tells *Us* the 35-year-old wasn't bothered by her prince's less-than-charming behavior. "Kate knew William would be away on a boys' trip — it was planned long ago," notes the source. "Is it a surprise that they all drank a lot? Hardly. There was no fallout."

STIFF UPPER LIP

Indeed, by March 17, Kate was "all smiles" as she and William handed out sprigs of shamrock at the Irish Guards St. Patrick's Day parade, says an onlooker. Afterward, the pair hopped a private jet to Paris (Kate's hairdresser Amanda Tucker blew out her tresses midflight) to begin a two-day tour of the French capital. Following a meeting with President François Hollande at the Elysée Palace, the couple enjoyed a black-tie dinner hosted by Britain's ambassador to France and visits to the Eiffel Tower and Musée d'Orsay. Not on the agenda: any discussions of William's misstep. "Kate trusts William," says the insider. "I think what bothered her the most was suggestions there are now problems in their marriage. That couldn't be further from the truth."
